WHO SHOULD ATTEND

Physicians, nurse practitioners, nurses, physician assistants, case managers, patient educators, social workers, counselors, nutritionists, dentists, dental hygienists, pharmacists and other who provide or plan to provide care to HIV-infected adults.

COURSE DESIGN

Course is classroom-based with lectures, case presentations, and question and answers, covering:

- HIV testing and counseling
- HIV pathogenesis, transmission, and primary infection: regional focus on minority populations
- Recognition of HIV at all stages of infection
- Antiretroviral therapy
- Symptomatic HIV/AIDS and opportunistic infection
- Medical complications in HIV management
- HIV and oral health
- Women, pregnancy, and perinatal prevention
- Hepatitis and HIV
- Mental health and substance abuse issues and HIV
- Methamphetamine use and clinical HIV care
- Workplace safety and postexposure prophylaxis

SPONSORSHIP

OPTIONAL CLINICAL EXPERIENCE

SEATEC offers one to three days of clinical training experience to licensed physicians, nurse practitioners, physician assistants, nurses, dentists, and pharmacists. This clinical experience can be scheduled either alone or in conjunction with this course. Clinical experiences occur in a variety of HIV-intensive care settings in Atlanta or in rural facilities in Georgia and North Carolina. There is no extra fee for the clinical experience. The participant or his/her agency is responsible for transportation, lodging, meals and other expenses, unless otherwise agreed upon with SEATEC.
